As rightly stated by the Honourable Member, questions related to certification of aerodromes are under the responsibility and oversight of the Greek Competent Authority. The European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) in turn oversees the National Competent Authority after which, if non-compliance with EU law is detected and not being resolved, the Commission is formally notified by EASA and could raise a formal infringement procedure. To date, the Commission has not been notified by EASA to this end.

The Commission underlines the importance of ensuring the safety of operations of military aerodromes handling civil traffic in accordance with Article 2.5 of Regulation (EU) 2018/1139 (EASA)¹ and Article 7.4 of Regulation (EU) 2024/2803 (Single European Sky)², where applicable.
